(Ephesians 4:30, NKJV).

Thought to Pounder: The Holy Spirit awakens in us a desire to accept Jesus and His forgiveness of our sins. The Holy Spirit possesses a matchless power to make us overcomers and to enable us to reflect the beautiful character of Jesus. Finance Information (Tithes, Combined Budget & Expenses)

Tithes are sent directly to the Oregon Conference to support the aforementioned efforts.
