9:45 A.M. – Church at Study Lesson Topic: "The Person of Peter"

Memory Text: "But when he saw that the wind was boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink he cried out, saying, 'Lord, save me!' And immediately Jesus stretched out His hand and caught him, and said to him, 'O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" (Matthew 14:30, 31, NKJV).

Thought to Ponder: Peter is the author of two books (1 and 2 Peter) that bear his name. He was one of the early followers of Jesus, so Peter had a wealth of experiences from which, inspired by the Holy Spirit, he could draw in order to write these powerful letters. Peter appears often in the Gospels, revealing both his triumphs and failures. After the resurrection and ascension, Peter became a prominent early church leader. But most important, Peter knew what it was to make mistakes, to be forgiven, and to move forward in faith and humility. Having experienced for himself the grace of God, he remains a powerful voice for all of us who need to experience that same grace, as well.

Finance Information (Tithes, Combined Budget & Expenses)
