FINANCIAL EXPLANATION

Tithes (Conference Funds) - These monies are sent directly to the Oregon Conference to primarily support the preaching, pastoral, evangelistic work of ministers/Bible teachers. In addition, because Adventist schools are an ongoing ministry to students, tithe funds are used to subsidize selected administrative salaries and a percentage of salaries for teachers. Tithe provides for the support of local, union, division & General Conference services. Tithe is not used to purchase property, build churches or fund the general operations of churches or schools.

Local Combined Church Budget (Offerings) - These monies are used to help support our Children, Youth and Young Adults pursuing Christian Education and Sabbath School Ministries. Also supports local church ministries to include Women's, Health, Prison, Fellowship, Outreach, Music, and Benevolence Assistance as well as the ongoing church upkeep & maintenance. Lesson Memory Text: "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches" ([Revelation 2:7, NKJV](#)).

Thought to Ponder: He (John) was given a vision of the resurrected Christ in the heavenly sanctuary. Here, as with the psalmist, the Lord revealed to John some mysteries of this life and the struggles it brings. This sanctuary scene provided him with the assurance of Christ's presence and care - an assurance that John was to pass on to these churches and to the succeeding generations of Christians throughout the centuries until the end of this world's history. In addition to introducing Christ's ministry in the heavenly sanctuary, we looked at the first of His seven special messages to His church, addressed collectively to the seven churches in Asia, but which also have meaning for us today.
