Memory Text: “Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law” ([Romans 3:31](#)).

Thoughts to Ponder: In many ways Romans 4 gets to the foundation of the biblical doctrine of salvation by faith alone and to the heart of what began the Reformation. Indeed, 500 years ago this week it all began with Luther, and faithful Protestants have never looked back. By using Abraham-the paragon of holiness and virtue-as an example of someone who needed to be saved by grace without the deeds of the law, Paul left readers no room for misunderstanding. If the best one’s works and law-keeping weren’t enough to justify him before God, what hope does anyone else have? If it had to be by grace with Abraham, it has to be the same with everyone else, Jews and Gentiles. It is crucial to remember that for Paul, salvation is by grace; it’s something that is given to us, however undeserving we are
