### Church at Study

**Lesson Memory Text:** “So they read distinctly from the book, in the Law of God; and they gave the sense, and helped them to understand the reading” ([Nehemiah 8:8, NKJV](#)).

**Thought to Pounder:** The Jerusalem wall was finished. With the placement of the gates, the Israelites, under the leadership of Nehemiah, had thus completed the main task. When the wall was completed, the surrounding nations were in awe and recognized that this “was done by God” ([Neh. 6:16, NKJV](#)). The enemies realized that the God of Israel was real because, despite the incredible opposition & hatred the Israelites experienced, they still had completed the work they had set out to do. The following chapters (8-10) of Nehemiah describe an important series of events in the month of Tishri, the 7<sup>th</sup> month ([Neh. 8:2](#)). In these texts we can see examples of how the children of Israel were determined to obey the Word of God.
